

DATA FROM THE DEPARTMENTS OF THE LIBRES PROJECT

CASES OF WOMEN VICTIMS OF GBV BY TYPES OF VIOLENCE ACCORDING TO THE SPECIAL COMPREHENSIVE LAW FOR A LIFE FREE OF VIOLENCE FOR WOMEN (LEIV), 2020-2021

The department of the LibrES project with the highest number of femicides and homicides was San Salvador, with 35 cases (17 femicides and 18 homicides) for the year 2020 and 28 cases (19 femicides and 9 homicides) in 2021, representing a decrease in the year 2021 compared to 2020 of 20% in the number of victims.

Physical violence shows increase in all the departments of the LibrES project, where San Miguel is the one that increased the greatest amount, 51% for the year 2021 (437 cases) compared to the year 2020 (289 cases).

Sexual violence has a greater number of cases in the department of San Salvador, which in 2020 registered a total of 712 cases and in 2021 it was 945, which represents an increase of 33%.

Domestic violence shows a greater percentage increase in the number of cases in the department of La Libertad with 62% for the year 2021 (81 cases) compared to 2020 (50 cases).

Patrimonial violence shows that the department of the LibrES project with the highest number of cases is San Salvador with 1,262 for the year 2020 and in 2021 a total of 1,851, representing an increase of 48%.

DATA FROM THE MUNICIPALITIES OF THE LIBRES PROJECT

CASES OF WOMEN VICTIMS OF GBV IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF THE LIBRES PROJECT, 2020-2021

Municipalities: in that period, the three types of violence according to the LEIV and the municipalities of the LibrES project that presented the highest numbers of cases were: (a) in 2020, physical violence, patrimonial violence, sexual violence; San Salvador, Santa Ana and San Miguel, and (b) in the year 2021, patrimonial violence, physical violence, sexual violence; San Salvador, Santa Ana and San Miguel.



Type of violence: three types of violence were recorded according to the LEIV with a greater number of cases for the period in all the municipalities of the LibrES project: (a) in 2020, physical violence with 2,578 cases, patrimonial violence with 2,332 cases, and sexual violence with a total of 1,645 cases, (b) in the year 2021, patrimonial violence with 3,409 cases, physical violence with 3,227 cases and sexual violence with 2,134 cases.
